

## TAILOR MADE VISITS

Exmoor Zoo can cater for a variety of groups and age ranges, we are more than happy to tailor your visit to suit your requirements.

Our African Café is open daily for light lunches and refreshments, with food served until 4.00pm and drinks until 5.00pm in the summer. Alternatively you can bring a picnic and use a variety of picnic areas scattered around the zoo, such as the patio below the café, the covered picnic area at the Snack Shack or the tables in the playground. We can arrange special themed talks and tours, meals, cream teas, a tour guide, trails or quizzes and animal encounters as required.

## HIGH SEASON

During our High season (February 15th - November 2nd) we have organised activities happening every half hour from 11.00am to 4.00pm each day. These include encounter sessions, talks, feeding and supervised petting and handling activities.

Separate to all this, you could book your own group tour or private encounter session. These have to be pre-booked to ensure a dedicated member of staff is available.

Our gift shop is open daily. A wide range of gifts and souvenirs are displayed, including items such as cuddly toys, fair-trade goods, ornaments, Exmoor Zoo stationery, cards and T-shirts, to name but a few!

## HOW TO FIND US

We are situated approximately 12 miles outside Barnstaple.

**From the Barnstaple A361** turn left at the South Molton Roundabout heading towards Ilfracombe and Woolacombe, we are 10 miles down on the left.

**From Ilfracombe** get on the A399 heading towards South Molton, we are just after Blackmoor Gate on the right.

**From the M5**, take the A361 towards Barnstaple and turn right at the 3rd roundabout signposted Ilfracombe and Woolacombe (the A399), we are 10 miles along on the left.

### PARKING:

There is ample free parking, a coach park and designated disabled spaces.

# OUTREACH PROGRAMME

**Exmoor Zoo continues its outreach programme of visits; these are not expensive and within a twenty mile radius are only £100!**

These can be adapted to suit most clubs, societies and occasions. Carefully selected animals and bio facts accompany the zoo and are always popular. Usually the education staff are the show presenters, all of whom are CRB accredited and the zoo is fully covered by third party liability insurance. Copies of these and an agreed itinerary are available on request.



## COSTS

The outreach roadshow costs a basic £100.00. This is for one session at any one location within a 20 mile radius of the zoo. There will be a charge of £2.50 per extra mile over 20 miles (calculated by AA auto route). The roadshow has a duration of approximately 45-60 minutes (depending on agreed itinerary).
